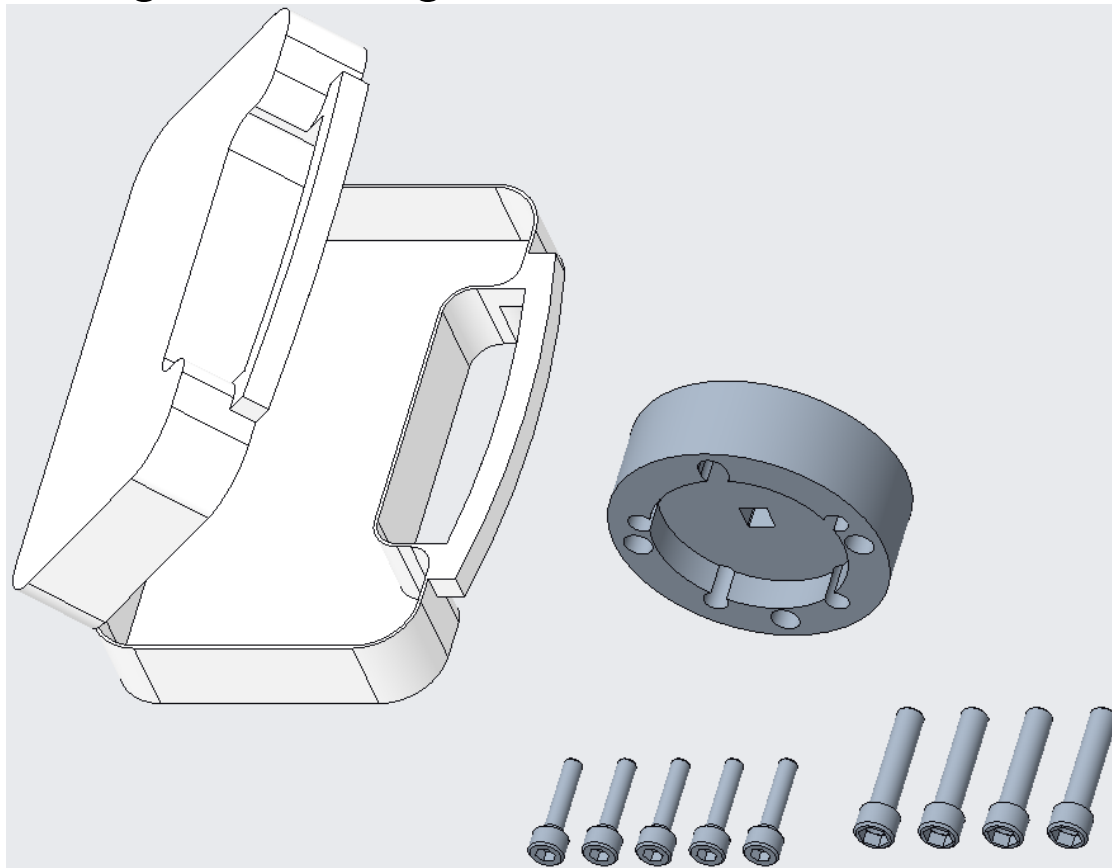

5573100 – Engine Barring Kit

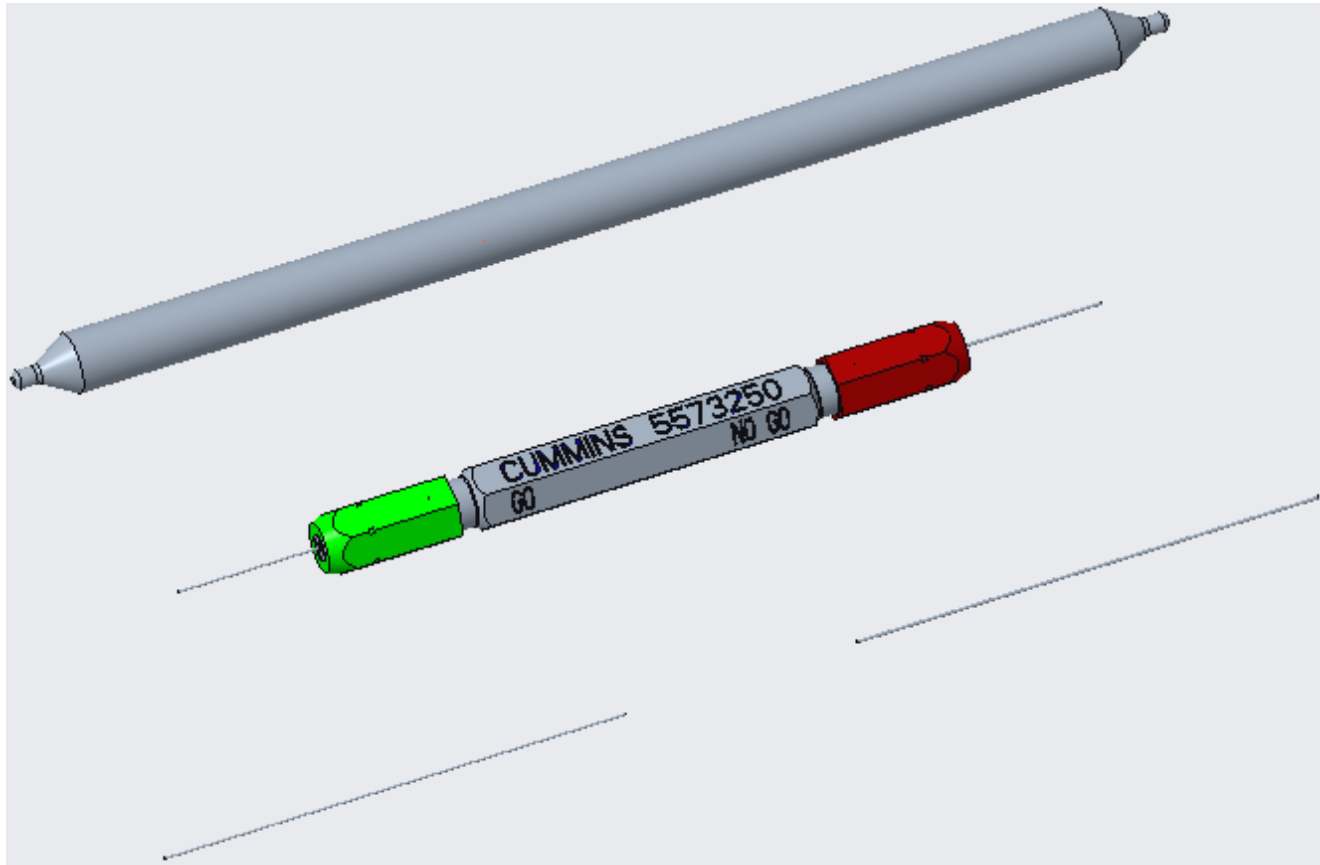


- This engine barring tool is designed to attach to the vibration damper (in place of a front PTO pulley, if equipped) to allow the barring of engines without starter ring gears (typically found on engines in hybrid drive applications).
- May also be used on engines that have ring gears but difficult access to the conventional barring port.
- Works on dampers with both four bolt and five bolt front PTO pulley mounting options.
- Recommended for many 9L engines.
- Due to be available in February 2021.

5572834 – Spark Plug Gapping Kit



- This kit is used to measure and adjust the spark plug gap on Cummins four electrode spark plugs.
- Recommended for original equipment spark plugs used in HSK78 engines.
